# **Evergreen Council on Problem Gambling Student Research Grants and Scholarships**

The Evergreen Council on Problem Gambling (ECPG) seeks to seed innovation through supporting student research and education in the fields of psychology, social work, cognitive, or behavioral sciences to address social issues as they apply to Gambling and Gaming Disorders in the following priority areas:

- addressing Gambling and Gaming Disorders as they impact at-risk and vulnerable populations
- understanding the connections between addictive behaviors and health
- understanding and eliminating stigma/intersectional stigmas and prejudice of Gambling and Gaming Disorders as Public Health issues (e.g., culture, race, gender, sexual orientation, religious beliefs, age, disability, and socioeconomic status)
- special concerns of populations that have historically been underrepresented in research on Gambling and Gaming Disorders
- understanding connections between Gambling Disorder and Suicide

# Advanced Undergraduate (Junior/Senior) Academic Scholarship

(Two cycles per year. Individuals are eligible for one scholarship per year up to \$2,500 each. Anticipate three awards given per year.)

A scholarship for undergraduate students with demonstrated financial need entering their Junior or Senior year studying psychology, social work, cognitive, or behavioral science, including coursework/studies on Gambling and/or Gaming Disorder Prevention, Treatment, and Recovery at an accredited College or University in Washington State.

Students who have completed their associate degree and are licensed Substance Use Disorder Professionals with an interest in pursuing a baccalaureate degree in psychology, social work, cognitive, or behavioral science as well as Washington State Gambling Counselor Certification will be given preference.

Each year, ECPG awards up to three scholarships of \$2,500; scholarship recipients are also eligible for continuing support beyond the first year based on academic achievement and progress toward degree completion. Recipients can use the scholarship to pay for tuition, fees, textbooks, and other direct educational costs.

### **Deadline:**

Term 1: October 1 Term 2: April 1

## **Eligibility**

- Be currently enrolled as an undergraduate student (Junior or Senior year) at an accredited Washington State college or university during the academic year.
- Applicants must be declared for a major in psychology, social work, cognitive, behavioral, addictions, or mental health fields for the Fall semester.
- Students who have been awarded an undergraduate degree are not eligible. - All scholarship applicants and recipients must maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher
- Applicants must be enrolled as full-time undergraduate students for Fall (minimum 12 credits).

### **Application Requirements**

(One-inch margins, 12-point Garamond/Times New Roman font, single space)

- Curriculum Vitae (CV) or Resumé: two-page maximum.
- **Current transcript:** Unofficial digital transcript should be submitted as a PDF to online application. Successful applicants must submit official transcripts before the scholarship is awarded.
- **Personal essay:** Three-page maximum; describe your past, current, and future involvement in the science and application of psychology/social work/cognitive/behavioral sciences with regard to Gambling and Gaming Disorders.
- **Two Letters of Recommendation:** at least one from a faculty member/advisor in Psychology/Social Work/Behavioral Health/Addictions.

### **Additional Information**

The Scholarship Committee has discretion in determining the amount of each award and the number of student recipients, depending on the availability of funds and the pool of applicants each year.

## **Requirements of Acceptance**

- 1. Awards are made to individuals. ECPG does not allow institutional indirect costs or overhead costs; funding for political or lobbying purposes; entertainment or fundraising expenses. By the end of the academic year, each award recipient must submit a final report (no more than three pages) specifying how the funds were used, which must be signed by the chair or head of the department or the student's faculty advisor.
- 2. Part of ECPG Student Advisory Committee commitment for minimum of one year.
- 3. Must take (ECPG Sponsored) 2-3 hours of education on Gambling and Gaming through ECPG.

### Please keep in mind:

• ECPG Staff will review all applications for eligibility. Incomplete or ineligible applications will not be considered.

- Your application materials (described in this section) must be received by ECPG on or before the application deadline.
- All applicants for the award will be notified of funding decisions via email within 30 days of submission deadline.
- Be sure to keep a copy of all submitted materials for your records.

### **Award Distribution**

Scholarship awards will be made directly to the student. Proof of class enrollment is required for all scholarship recipients before checks will be distributed.

The Evergreen Council on Problem Gambling is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization committed to providing services and programs for those with a gambling problem/gambling disorder, their families, employers, students, treatment professionals, and the greater community through gambling and gaming disorder treatment support, information, and education, advocacy, research, and prevention efforts. # Abbreviated Curriculum Vitae (CV) or Resumé

**Attach**: Two-page maximum; including scientific publications, presentations, research, and teaching experience (the curriculum vitae may contain only highlights and does not need to be a complete version). (One-inch margins, 12-point Garamond/Times New Roman font, single space)

# **Letters of Recommendation**

- One letter of recommendation should come from your primary faculty advisor. One page max.
- The second letter may come from other advisors and/or professors from your declared major department. One page max.
- Applicants should inform letter writers to adhere to a one-page limit. These letters should highlight the significance of your graduate work and research, as well as your potential for supporting the field of Gambling/Gaming Disorders in research, prevention, treatment, or recovery. Please do not arrange for more than two letters of recommendation to be submitted.
- The letter writers must submit the letters directly to the Evergreen Council on Problem Gambling -- ECPG/Dissertation Research Grants via email to <a href="mailto:studentaid@evergreencpg.org">studentaid@evergreencpg.org</a>.

The student applying for the grant is responsible for confirming that the faculty members have emailed their letters before the deadline. This is the student's responsibility, and applications that do not include both letters of recommendation before the application deadline will be disqualified.
